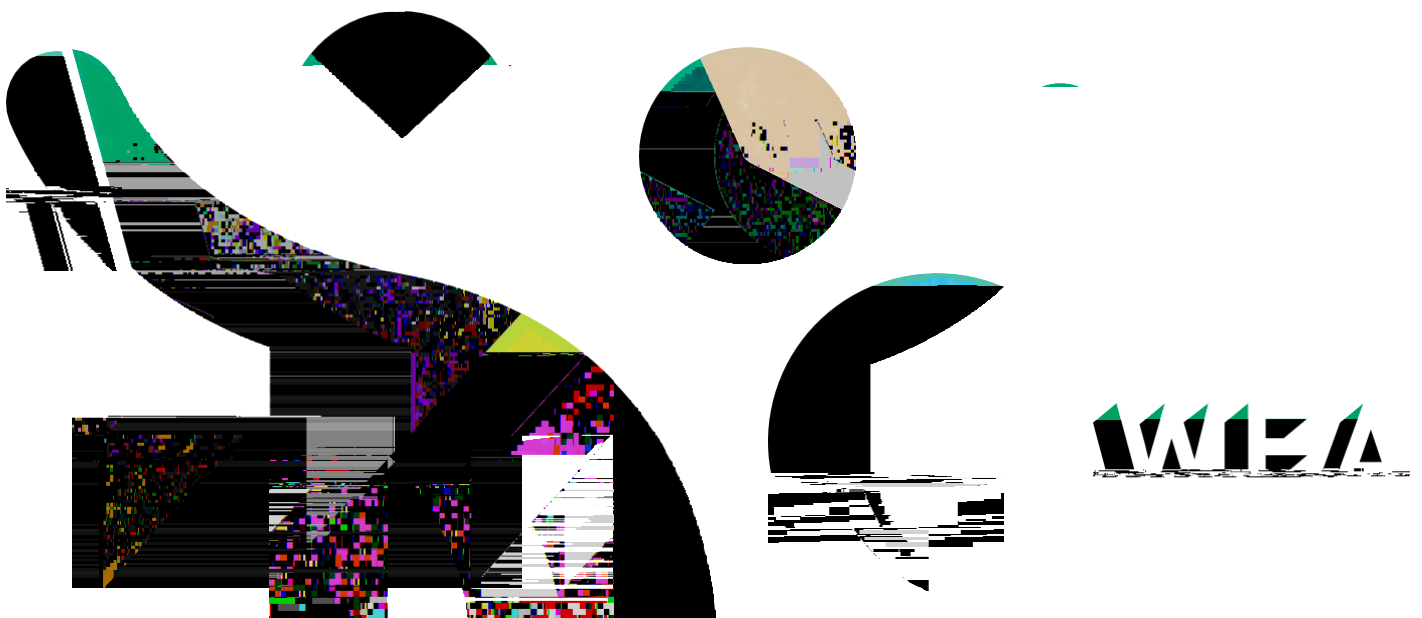


Safeguarding: our responsibilities and WEA contacts

All tutors are trained in safeguarding procedures.
